
Ottawa, 29th January, 1908.

Sir:--

In reply to your letter of the 22nd instant, enclosing the sum of \$14.40, amount of interest on your land in Michel Reserve, I beg to inform you that it is not the practice of the Department to accept interest alone as payment on land, but when a part payment is forwarded, this sum is divided between principal and interest and placed to the credit of the purchaser on his land.

The amount of principal and interest overdue on your land is \$502.40, and as the amount forwarded is very small I have to ask you to be good enough to forward and additional sum amounting to \$75.00, which will be added to the amount already received and divided as above stated and placed to your credit.
