Oats 15 Ac. Estimate 600 Bu.

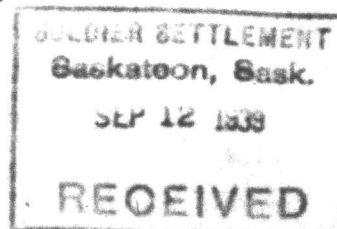
SUBSERFALLOW. . . . 10 Ac. Satisfactory. Breaking Nil.

CULTIVATION. . . . This farm is leased to a good operator and work well done. Buildings are vacant.

TAXES. Current 16.80. Arrears 34.60.

REMARKS. This man and his family are at present in the district. from British Columbia. He is working on a threshing outfit and so far I have not located him. The wife states the payment in the past has been sent to Ottawa and they intend making a settlement this year. This will be followed up and try for share of crop here. Details of crop were given by lessee(Ralph Pathke) and further follow-up on Sept.9th. Threshing just completed on 9th. Wheat on this quarter 1825 Bu.
