As you do not mention when the chiefs of the two bands referred to died, I beg to remind you of the contents of the circular sent you on Feb. 10, 1911, namely, that when a vacancy occurs in the office of chief or councillor in any band in your agency, whether by death, resignation or otherwise, you must report the fact promptly to the Department in a special letter, instead of either delaying to advise the Department or conveying the information in a letter dealing with some other subject.
