With reference to your letter of the 17th ultimo, regarding the erection of a light-house on Birnie Island, near the entrance to Port Simpson Harbor, North West Coast Agency, I have the honor to enclose herewith for the information of the Department a duplicate of a communication, of the 18th instant, to-day received from Mr. Agent Morrow who states that the Port Simpson Indians, who are concerned in the site on which the light-house stands, are at present all scattered and a meeting of them cannot just at present be had. The Agent promises, however, to take the matter up as soon as a meeting of the band can be arranged.
