association of the European, Allies in the settlement with Germany. The Americans appear to share this view. (On this point Strang's observations to Ritchie are important). The Russian attitude has been stubbernly opposed to the modification of the Tripartite basis both of the signature of the Instrument and of the execution of the settlement with Germany. The United Kingdom Government appear to hope that the Russians may later be induced to modify their stand.

Would you approve my arranging an interview with Winant and discussing these questions with him informally?
