I wish to refer to your letter of October 2nd regarding allotment of various Reserves to the Bands in the Clayoquot District. I am in receipt of a letter from the Department regarding the allotment of Reserves 30 to 34 inclusive which are shown in the new Schedule of Reserves as follows:

No. 30, Indian Island - Clayoquot Tribe	93.60 acres.
No. 31, Vargas Island - Clayoquot Tribe (Kelsemart Band)	27.00 "
No. 32, Bartlett Island - Clayoquot Tribe (Ahousaht Band)	172.00 "
No. 33, Kut-co-us Point - Clayoquot Tribe (Ahousaht Band)	98.20 "
No. 34, Hismit Fishery - Clayoquot Tribe (Manhouset Band)	8.80 "

Please let me have a detailed report in duplicate covering the occupation and use of these Reserves by the various Bands and your recommendation with respect to the allotment of each. It is noted from the report of the Royal Commission that Reserves 31 to 34 inclusive were allotted as indicated above but no information is given regarding the ownership of Reserve No. 30.
