My Lord:

I have the honour to forward herewith, for your Lordship's information, upon the advise of my Ministers, a Minute of my Executive Council on the subject of the Indian Land Question in British Columbia, in reference to which this Government was apprised by the Government of the Dominion in October, 1874, that a communication would be addressed to your Lordship conveying the views of that Gov. ernment: and I beg to state that, in accordance with the desire of my Council, I have this day, by Despatch to The Secretary of State for Canada, signified the acceptance by this Government, of the proposals made by the Dominion Government, for the settlement of this question, and which are set forth in the Minute of Council now enclosed.
