many defilements, but the Fount of cleansing is ever flowing in Her midst, and one day she shall be presented to Her Lord "a glorious Church, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing" (Ephes. v. 27).

Are you in vital connection with the Lord Jesus Christ in this His Divine Body, sharing the life, the worship, the work now, and the glory hereafter? If so, you share in the COMMUNION OF SAINTS, i.e. the tellowship between God's true children, whether members of the Church here or in Paradise.

"One family we dwell in Him One Church above, beneath."

Let us realize this Christian fellowship in prayer for others, in words of courtesy and acts of kindness. Satan works for separation, God for union in the family. On which side are you?

THE HOLY COMMUNION

In ancient times God taught man that He must be approached through different sacrifices. The greatest of these was that of the Passover (Ex. xII. 3) which commemorated the salvation of the first-born and the deliverance from Egypt. This great sacrifice Jesus Christ transformed into the Holy Communion (Lk. xXII. 15) which henceforth became the great Service of the Gospel, celebrated every Lord's day (xx. 7.)
