

ANNUAL REPORT.

The Executive Committee of the Associated Alumni of Acadia College beg leave to submit their Sixth Annual Report. The society numbers at present 68 members. The names of 20 persons have been dropped from our list of membership—not having paid their dues or been heard from for several years. On the other hand we have had additions to the number of ten, the most of whom, we are glad to say, have been from the graduating classes of the few previous years.

By the Treasurer's Report herewith submitted, it will be seen that the sum of fifty-nine dollars has been received from subscribers during the past year. But as usual a large balance remains unpaid for arrears. In accordance with the Bye-laws of the Society the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, together with all of the Directors, go out of office at the present time, all of whom, however, are eligible for re-election.

All of which is respectfully submitted.

NOTE.—By the report of a Special Committee adopted at the last Annual Meeting, membership in this Association is henceforth limited to Graduates of Acadia College, with the exception of non-graduates, now members, and the object to be kept in view by the Association is declared to be the renewing around the portals of the College, the friendships of Collegiate life, and rendering permanent, feelings of attachment to the College, and by such auxiliary means affording a guarantee of the life-long devotion of the members of the Association to the interests of the College and through her to the cause of Education throughout the Province.
