ORDERED, That Mr. Taschereau do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and defire their concurrence.

The order of the day, for the House in Committee on the Ordinance of the 28th, George 3d, Chapter 8th, for regulating persons, practising Physic and Surgery, being read:

The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. M. Caron took the Chair of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair.

And Mr. M. Caron reported, that the Committee had come to a refolution, which he was directed to submit to the House whenever it shall please to receive the same.

Ordered, That the Report be now received.

And he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's table, where the resolution was again read, and is as solloweth, viz.

RESOLVED, That it is the opinion of this Committee, that the Ordinance of the 28th, George 3d, Chapter 8th, for regulating persons, practising Physic and Surgery, in this Province, is insufficient, and should be amended.

On motion of Mr. Blanchet, seconded by Mr. Bourdages,

Ordered, That the question of concurrence be now put on the said resolution.

Accordingly, the faid resolution was again read, and the question of concurrence being put thereon, it was agreed to by the House.

RESOLVED, That this House doth concur with the Committee in the faid resolution.
