### Capt. Scott's Films at Casino.

These pictures are freely acknowledged to be the most phenomenal of any ever secured in the South Polar regions, and to be accurate and authentic records of the strange bird and animal life extant in that cold climate. Among the most striking and interesting subjects may be mentioned the quaint little Adelie Penguins, whose antics are not unlike those of little old men of genteel demeanor, while their appearance is such as to arouse spontaneous laughter. The penguin's mortal enemy, the skua-gull, is also depicted in the very act of stealing the eggs of the penguins; a trick they wait for hours at a time to perform. They never fail to purloin an egg when it is left unprotected.

The beautiful Weddell seals are also depicted in their native habitat, hunted by their arch enemy, the killer whale. A film showing an old mother seal and her baby, relentlessly pursued by a school of these wolves of the Antarctic, was recorded, and you may believe that it is exciting and thrilling. The whales succeeded in exhausting the seals, consequently the last seen of mother and baby is when they dive off of the ice and swim downward, with sixteen ferocious enemies close behind. One can only surmise what happened when those vicious brutes overtook the helpless calf and its devoted mother.

What is unquestionably the greatest novelty ever filmed is flashed on the screen about the middle of the entertainment when the majestic old volcano, Mt. Erebus, is shown in a state of actual eruption, belching forth enormous quantities of fire, smoke and lava. This film was obtained at a great cost and perilous risk, but it is worth all and more than its cost, as it is the first and only instance on record of a crater being cinematographed in action.

Captain Scott and his fearless comrades are shown at work, at play, and at rest, to say nothing of in action transporting their provisions and instruments across the desolate waste. The trains consisted of Siberian ponies, Siberian dogs and last, but by no means least, huge motor sledges which dragged tons and tons of provisions over the sea-ice.

It is noteworthy that the winter of Captain Scott and his comrades spent in the Antarctic was the coldest ever recorded by mortal man. Another fact of equal importance is that the widows and orphans of the departed heroes, own and control the rights to the motion pictures taken on Captain Scott's journey, and that they can be exhibited only through their agents. This means that the dependents of the sacrificed explorers at least have a means of self-support, unconsciously provided by their husbands and fathers.
