TO-DAY'S MESSAGES.

CIVIC MANAGEMENT IN IRISH FREE STATE CAUSING TROUBLE.
DUBLIN, May 20.

The Local government minister of the Irish Free State issued an order to-day dissolving the Dublin Corporation (or City Council) as from this evening. The order states that the Minister on investigation finds the duties of the members not being duly and effectually discharged, therefore he has appointed three Commissioners to perform the Council duties. The problem of civic management is to be thoroughly examined. In the light of modern experience the London correspondent of the Daily Telegraph says the concession granted to the Irish Free State in the matter of having an independent Minister at Washington already has had an important result: in that the Canadian Government has decided that it must have equal advantages. The Telegraph correspondent proceeds to state that this concession to the Irish Free State is bound to have far reaching consequences, as the Imperial representation in foreign countries will be undermined and a constitutional problem of considerable gravity must be solved if there is an Irish Minister to Washington. Why not a Canadian Minister to Paris or an Australian Minister to Tokyo? The control of the Imperial foreign relations will become an impossible task.

MEIGHEN NAMED FOR JOB IN IRISH FREE STATE.
OTTAWA, May 20.

"I have not heard anything of it," said Hon. Arthur Meighen to-night when questioned in regard to a London cable despatch that he is likely to be named Chairman of the Ulster Boundary Commission. A special cable from London to the Montreal Star says that former Premier Meighen Hon. Arthur Meighen will be named chairman of the Ulster Boundary Commission. This was requested of Sir Robert Borden who refused to act. The British Government seems anxious to obtain a Canadian for the task as the Canadian relationship to the British Crown having been taken as a model for the Free State in the Irish Treaty.

PHILIP HOOD, WELL KNOWN BANK MAN, DEAD.
HALIFAX, May 21.

Philip Hood, Inspector in the Maritime Provinces for the Bank of Montreal, died here today after a fortnight's illness. He had been suffering from the District Superintendent, A. E. Nash, while the latter was absent in England. He was born in Yarmouth and entered the Bank in 1904, since which time he has been stationed in Winnipeg, St. John's, Nfld., and Montreal.

NORTH ATLANTIC PRACTICALLY CLEAR OF ICE.
HALIFAX, N.S., May 21.

The United States cutter Modoc arrived here this morning from ice patrol and sideswiped the Western Union pier while docking, denting a corner of her plating. The Modoc has been north of Forty-Nine and saw no ice during the entire trip, although reports of various bergs were investigated. The North Atlantic has not been so clear of ice in twenty years, the Modoc reports.

COLLISION SAID TO BE FAULT OF NELD VESSEL.
HALIFAX, N.S., May 21.

Capt. Reid, of the Car Ferry, P.E.I., declared in a statement that the accident off Halifax, N.S., on Monday morning, when the ferry struck and damaged the Nfld. sch. Gladys Bullen, was the fault of the smaller craft; and declared that no fog horn signal was heard aboard the steamer. He said that it a fog horn had been sounded properly by the sch. the accident would have been avoided.

RUSSIA TO RAISE LOAN FOR PRE WAR DEBTS.
LONDON, May 21.

The offer to set aside a lump sum to cover the pre war debts of the Russian Government to British subjects, if a long term loan could be arranged with the assistance of the British Government, was made by the Russian delegates at yesterday's session of the Anglo-Soviet Conference. The Russians said they would not consider claims of those who held Russian bonds before March 12, 1917. The British delegates replied, that the British Government would not undertake to guarantee such a loan, but would take a sympathetic attitude towards the efforts of the Russians to raise a loan privately.

BRITISH AVIATOR STILL GOING STRONG.
CALCUTTA, May 21.

JAMAICA TO BREAK AGREEMENT WITH CANADA.
KINGSTON, J.A., May 21.

On the ground that the British Government has decided to break its agreement as regards preferential rates it is said that the Legislative Council of Jamaica proposes to revise the Jamaica tariff in a manner that will materially benefit United States goods. Under the existing preferential agreement Jamaica exacts 25 per cent more duty on various foreign articles imported into the colony than against similar articles from Great Britain and fifty per cent more in case of cotton piece goods.

ONTARIO HEALTH OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION ON THE MENTALLY DEFICIENT.
TORONTO, May 21.

The elimination of imbecile or mentally abnormal from society, so far as it was possible under organized modern conditions formed the subject of a lengthy discussion yesterday at the annual meeting of the Ontario Health Officers' Association. Several of the speakers came out boldly with the statement that the reproduction of the mentally subnormal at an alarming rate would have to be stopped either by segregation or sterilization.

AND THEY TALK OF DISARMAMENT.
WASHINGTON, May 21.

At least \$750,000,000 must be expended if the United States navy is to equal Great Britain in strength, the House was told yesterday by chairman Butler of the naval committee. Before the close of the present session, he said, action will be sought on a bill designed to establish so far as United States is concerned the 5-5-3 arms conference ratio.

ROBBERS BAND ACTIVE IN POLAND.
WARSAW, May 21.

All Poland is roused in consequence of despatches from the eastern regions stating that a robber band numbering one hundred well armed men two days ago raided over the Soviet frontier and pillaged village of Kraszewicz 18 miles from the border killing or wounding some twenty inhabitants, including a church pastor. The robbers cut the telephone and telegraph lines and escaped back into Russia.

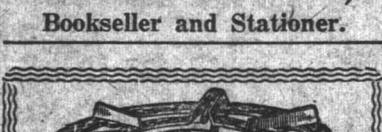

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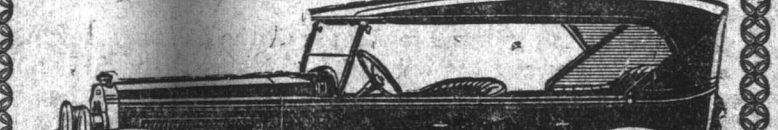
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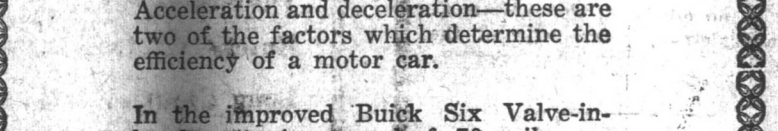


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
