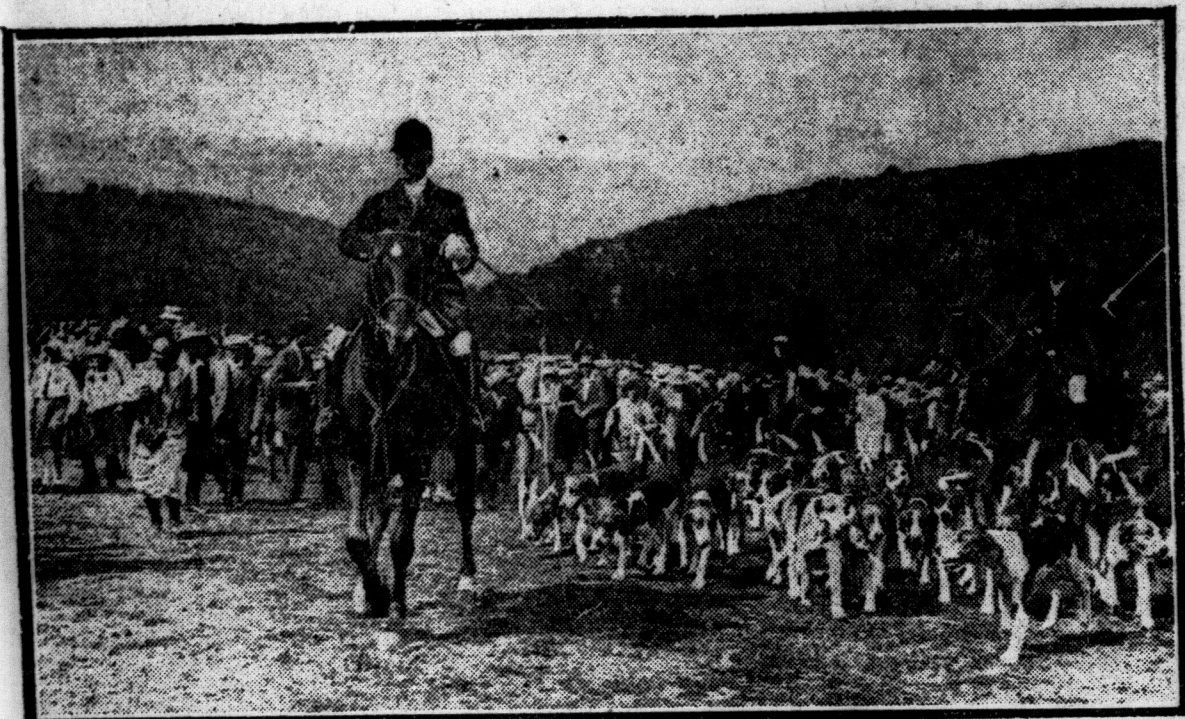


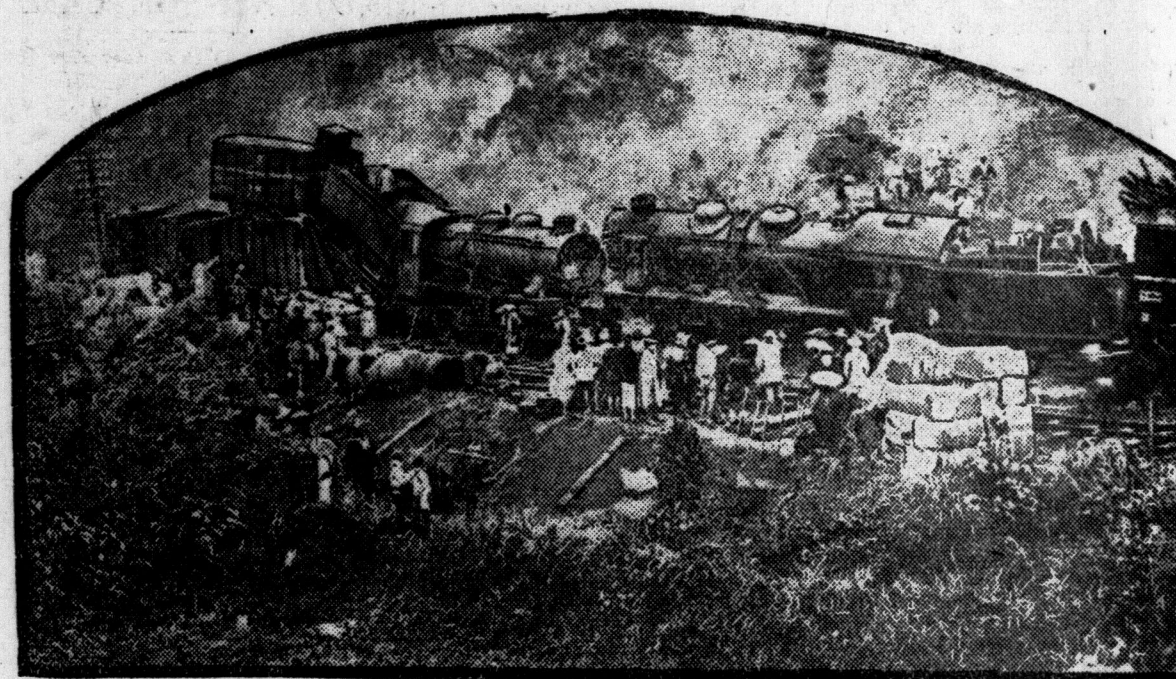

Even a world's famed tenor can enjoy fooling with a "grown-up's toy." He is Mario Chamlee, seen on his arrival in New York from Europe.



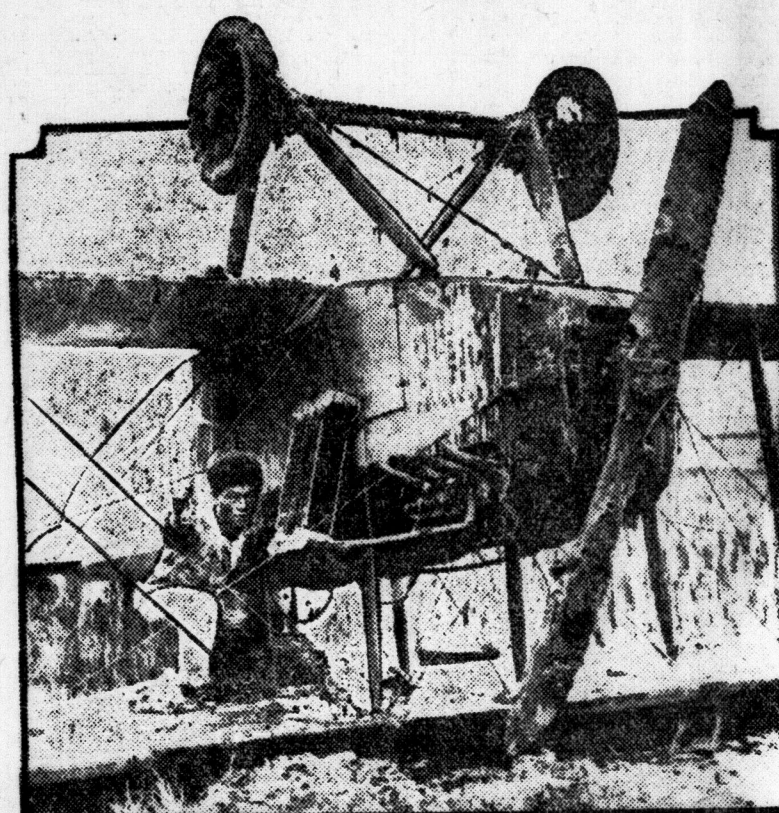

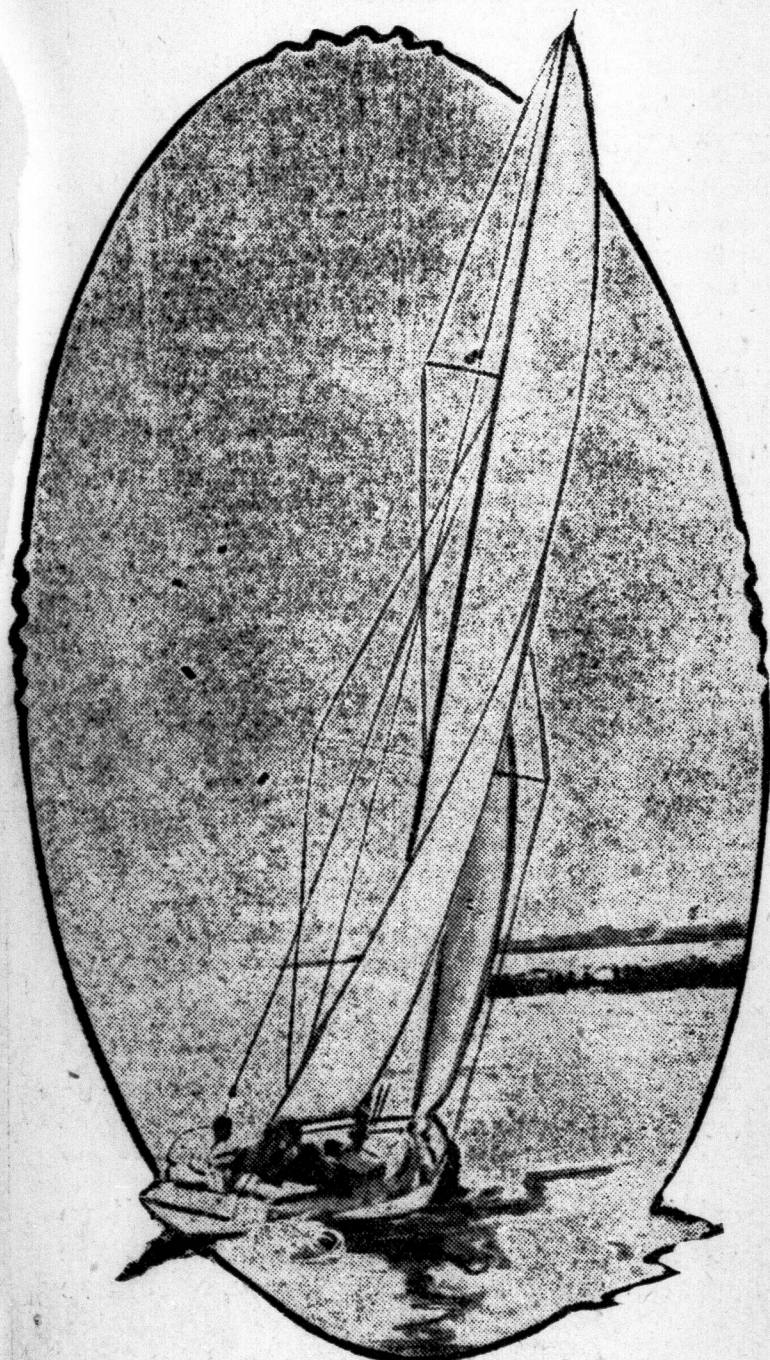
Picturesque street lights are seen in some parts of Japan. On the right are rows of stone lanterns to light the pathway.



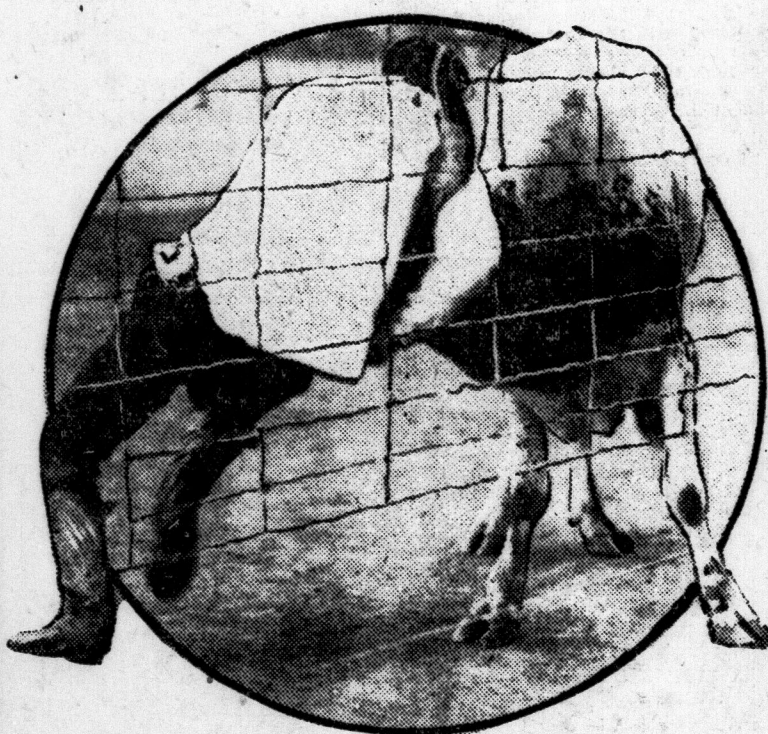
Syed Ali, a mahout, has started something new by broadcasting customary orders to his elephant at some miles distant.

Photograph shows Carls Seitz, Socialist and leader of the Austrian National Council. He is accredited with being a clever politician.



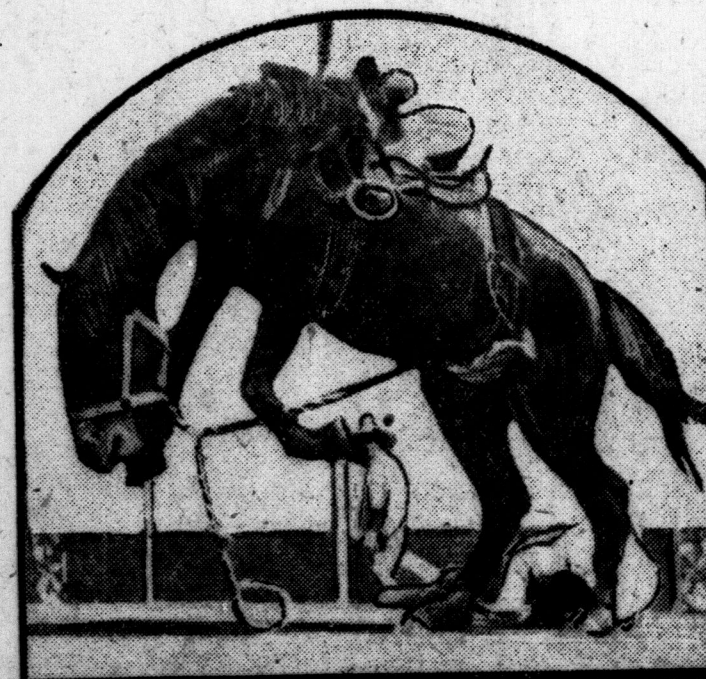
