


Colonel W. W. Wiggin, the master of the Devon and Somerset staghounds, leads the pack at the opening meet at Cloutsham, near Oxford.

Florence MacBeth, said to be the most beautiful woman on the stage, has been engaged by a Chicago opera company for fourteen performances.




Picturesque street lights are seen in some parts of Japan. On the right are rows of stone lanterns to light the pathway




