Commercial travellers want the election law amended so that they can vote by mail when away from home during polling day.

To overcome the difficulty which the government has placed in the way of getting postage stamps when one wants them the Toronto Star suggests a penny in the slot machine. Something certainly should be done to enable stamp users to get stamps when they want them without having to wait the convenience of the post office. It's a wonder the government hasn't solved the problem long ago.

It is reported that the government is considering the advisability of asking the Legislature at the coming session to vote a sum of money to be used in the establishment of at least two agricultural schools for different sections of the older parts of the province. One story is to the effect that the districts in which these institutions will be established have already been selected, and that the announcement on this point will be made when the vote is asked.

T. H. Lennox, M. P. P. for North York, has prepared a bill for presentation to the Legislature at its coming session which provides for taxing of all race meets on a basis of gate receipts, a return of which must be made to the government. Taxes so collected are to be expended among farmers in prizes for horseflesh. This system has been adopted in some states of the Union, where it has been found that race meets and race horses were entirely foreign to farm interests, and

Conditions in the West.
Ottawa, Jan. 14.—Reports received by the Department of the Interior from over sixty points in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta show that unusually severe weather and heavy snow is general in the three Provinces. Manitoba, Eastern and Northern Saskatchewan and Northern Alberta have from two to three feet of snow. In Manitoba and Saskatchewan the freight service is demoralized and the passenger train service is a day late. Some districts report plenty of fuel, but in others the fuel situation is serious. From almost all points come complaints of the tie-up of grain shipments and of the resulting financial situations. The ranching country reports some losses, but also reports that snow is not seriously deep.

Council elect for the township of Brooke for the year 1907 met in Code's hall, Alvington, at the hour appointed by statute.

Present—Reeve Darvill, Deputy Reeve Munro, Councillors Wm. Kelly, W. J. Bourne and John Spearman.

Kelly—Spearman, that G. R. Shirley and W. H. Risk be re appointed as auditors for the present year.—Carried.

Munro—Spearman, that W. G. Willoughby be re appointed clerk at old salary.—Carried.

Munro—Kelly, that Archie B. Aton be appointed assessor at a salary of \$80.00.—Carried.

Bourne—Spearman, that Jas. Johnston be appointed a member of the Board of Health for three years, and Dr. J. B. Martyn as Medical Health officer.—Carried.

Munro—Spearman, that W. J. Hanna be appointed seonitor at a retaining fee of \$30.—Carried.

D. Whitehead applied for pay for one lamb and one ewe worried, damages placed at \$3.00. Mr. Whitehead was paid the sum of \$5.33 on motion of Spearman and Kelly.

John W. Smith applied in writing to have 9 10 drain from head to outlet cleaned out. Geo. Westcott applied to have 6 7 sideroad drain cleaned out right through.

A. W. Wallis applied for drain on 6-7 con. from 12 to 15 sideroad to be cleaned out, tile preferred.

Spearman—Bourne, that engineer be instructed to examine drains, and if repairs are necessary to report with a view to enable council to clean out same.—Carried.

Spearman—Bourne, that tender of Alvington Free Press be accepted at \$100.00 per year for ordinary printing and \$1.00 per page for bylaws.—Carried.

G. H. Norworthy, Esq., Manager of Merchants Bank, applied to have the township account transferred there. Rate of interest on loans to be 5 per cent. and 3 per cent. allowed on the daily deposit, on deposit.—Carried.

Mr. H. H. Middleton applied for the corporation account on the same terms as last year.

Darvill—Bourne, that matter of placing account be laid over for one month and that account be placed with bank giving best terms.—Carried.

R. Burgess applied to have Wm. Shultis, an aged and infirm old man, sent to the House of Refuge.

Munro—Kelly, that the Reeve be authorized to send Mr. Shultis to the House of Refuge.

W. E. Fitzgerald, on behalf of John H. Lucas, claimed pay for interest on amount of costs of McClure Bryon suit illegally collected. No action.

By-law introduced confirming appointments of township officers.

Munro—Bourne, that by law be read a third time and finally passed.—Carried.

Letter read re petitioning government to change laws relating to highways.

Spearman—Munro, that this council comply with the request of the Ontario Municipal Association by petitioning the Legislature to amend Section 606, of the Municipal Act and relieve municipalities from a portion of their present heavy responsibility for the non-repairs of highways.—Carried.

Munro—Bourne, that council do now adjourn to meet in the Village of Inwood, on Saturday, the 2nd day of February, 1907.—Carried.
