THE MUNICIPAL ACT.

(R. S. O. 1887, cap. 84.)

(CONTINUED.)

NOTE TO SECTION 340.—It will be observed that sub-  
section 2 of section 340 (pages 29-30 of JOURNAL)  
has been repealed, and s-s. 2 of 53 V. c. 50, s. 9, as  
amended by 54 V. c. 42, s. 10 substituted. Under  
this section a Council may pass by-laws for con-  
tracting debts, etc., within its jurisdiction, subject  
to certain restrictions and provisions, which may be  
enumerated as follows :—

1. If the by-law relates to the purchase of public works,  
it must name a day when the by-law is to take effect,  
otherwise it will take effect on the day of the pass-  
ing.
