THE MUNICIPAL ACT.

(CONTINUED.)

Note to Section 340.—It will be observed that subsection 2 of section 340 (pages 29-30 of Journal) has been repealed, and s-s. 2 of 53 V. c. 50, s. 9, as amended by 54 V. c. 42, s. 10 substituted. Under this section a Council may pass by-laws for contracting debts, etc., within its jurisdiction, subject to certain restrictions and provisions, which may be enumerated as follows:—

 If the by-law relates to the purchase of public works, it must name a day when the by-law is to take effect, otherwise it will take effect on the day of the passing.
