



To Scale Fish Easily .- Have ready a large pan of boiling water. Stick a "flesh fork" through the head of the fish, immerse quickly three times in the scalding hot water. Not only the scales, but the skin will slip off easily, and a tedious task, if done the old way, becomes a very easy and simple one.

BOILED ONIONS .- After taking of the outer skin let them soak in cold water for a couple of hours, or longer if you like them mild; let them be-cooked in boiling water, which should be pretty strongly salted, drain off the water as soon as they are almost done, then let them simmer in milk until quite tender; add a good bit of butter, pepper and salt.
