PANIC IN ROME.

A "Reign of Terror" said to be anticipated.

LONDON, May 7.—A letter from Rome says the public officials at Rome as well as the people have been in a state of panic for a week or two.

The most prominent are the fall of the Crispi ministry, the accession of the Rudini ministry, the strong public demand for an equalization of expenses and receipts without fresh taxation, the diplomatic troubles between Italy and the United States, and the explosion of Pozzo Pantaleo, which caused so much damage and alarm in Rome and vicinity.

On May Day, the letter says, the natural excitability of the workmen was worked up to fever heat and the wildest rumors were circulated by those who had every thing to gain and nothing to lose by a popular disturbance.

The anarchists and police took place in a narrow street here today. Twelve shots were exchanged and several persons were wounded.
