They must understand the care and management  
of horses, and be able to ride well.

The minimum height is 5 feet 8 inches, the  
minimum chest measurement 35 inches, and the  
maximum weight 175 pounds.

The term of engagement is five years.

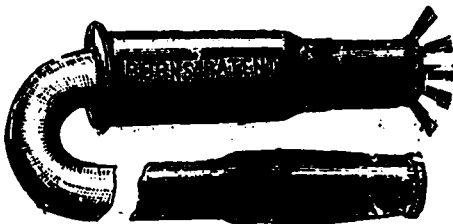

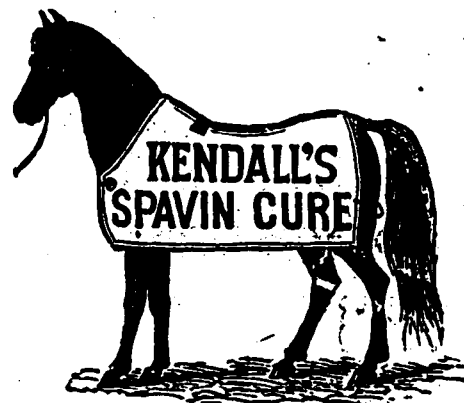
