PROVIDED, that no tariff item, description of products or rate of duty in Schedule V shall apply or be deemed to apply to goods the importation of which into Canada was, prior to the coming into force of this Agreement, prohibited under the provisions of Section 13 (and listed in Schedule "C") of the Customs Tariff of Canada.

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
