Dear Ambassador Hills:

I have the honour to refer to discussions at the Canada-United States Trade Commission on November 30, 1989, regarding the acceleration of the reduction of tariffs on certain goods under Article 401(5) of the Canada-United States Free Trade Agreement.

I have the honour to propose that the attached accelerated implementation Schedules shall become an integral part of the Free Trade Agreement and replace and supersede the implementation Schedules for those goods contained in the Agreement.

I have the further honour to propose, if you agree, that this letter and the attached Schedules, which are authentic upon verification in English and French, together with your reply and its attached Schedules, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, amending the Tariff Schedules contained in Annex 401.2-A and Annex 401.2-B of the Free Trade Agreement, which shall be implemented by both Parties with effect from April 1, 1990.
