

3. The Canadian side informed the Soviet side of the interest of Dalhousie University in conducting an exchange of one professor annually for 3 months with the Moscow State University;

4. The Canadian side informed the Soviet side of the interest of the Alberta Government's Ministry of Education, Language Services Branch, in developing student and teacher exchange programmes with appropriate Soviet institutions with a view to enhancing Ukrainian language skills, exposing participants to a new language and culture, developing an appreciation for languages and cultures of the Soviet Union, improving teaching skills and providing opportunities for improving curriculum development. Both sides agreed to discuss the possibility of putting in place such exchanges;

5. The Canadian side informed the Soviet side of the Quebec Government's desire to promote the study of Quebec francophone literature abroad. Accordingly, the Quebec Government proposes to send, at its expense, two specialists to the USSR to examine the possibility of promoting the study of Quebec francophone literature at the Moscow State University;
