As previously roparted to all offices, the organization of the Topartment in Ottawa was revised in January. Politioal work was edistributed under three Divisions, reporting to the Associate juder Secretary. The First Political Division will deal with ${ }_{\mathrm{sp}} \mathrm{ec}^{c i a l}$ political problems, including questions of world security rganization; the Second Political Division will deal with onnonwealth and European affairs; and the Third Political Division ill deal with American and Far Fastern affairs. Mr. Ritchie, -Glazebrook and Mr. Macdonnell will head the First, Second and mird Political Divisions respectively. The Special Division and the Legal Division will report to the Legal Adviser and the Diplomatic, Bconomic and Information Divisions will report directly 0 the Under Secretary.

Mr. Graham Morrow was appointed to the Department in Ottawa ${ }^{\text {8 }}$. a Foreign Service Officer, Grade 4, on January 22.

Mr. Darcy NicGreer arrived in Paris, on January 26, to take up nis duties at the Canadian Brnbassy.
