

In addition to the special scholar programme, it was agreed that China could place undergraduates and postgraduates in Canadian institutions through other arrangements acceptable to both countries.

The Chinese government agreed to promote accessibility for Canadian scholars and students to its institutions of higher learning by facilitating travel in China, access to research materials and attendance at regular courses. Discussions will be held between the Chinese Ministry of Education and the Canadian Embassy in Peking to promote such access for Canadian students, postgraduates, and university professors, including specialists in social sciences, humanities and science and technology.

As a further sign of their interest in promoting friendship and understanding between the two countries through education, Canada and the People's Republic of China have agreed to encourage the establishment of relations between their respective universities and colleges.
