Forms of Proceeding

"from..... to withdraw his amend-"ment?" If there are no objections, he says: "The amendment is withdrawn," and then puts the question on the main motion. If there are objections to the withdrawal, either of an amendment, or of the original motion, a division must take place.

77. If an amendment to an amendment is Amendment moved, the Speaker says: "In amendment to to amend-"the proposed amendment, it is moved by " Is it your, &c., to adopt the said amendment "to the proposed amendment," and sits down. After debate, he says: "The question, Hon-"ourable Senators, is on, &c. Those in favour, "&c., &c." (Division as at page 35. M. 288, sag.; B. 317-318.

78. If the amendment to the amendment when is carried, he says: 'The question, Honour- amendment to "able Senators, is now on the amendment carried. "as amended, &c." If it is lost, he says: "The question now, Honourable Senators, " is on the amendment to the original mo-"tion; is it your pleasure to adopt the amend-"ment, &c.?" M. 289-290, sq.
