

Dear Mr. Stroud:

I returned a day or two ago from a journey South. While at Atlanta I asked several persons about W. Earl Hopper, of the Hopper Peace Foundation of Oglethorpe University, but elicited no important information. It appears that he has written to certain institutions offering his services to them. In no case, however, had the matter received consideration so that the impressions were vague. One of the presidents said he thought he could send me some information. It has not been received, but should it come in I shall be glad to pass it on to Mr. Douglas.
