including the representative from the Institute of Parasitology, for the round trip from Montreal to Halifax, N.S. It is understood that Dr. Parnell will not be able to make the round trip but will disembark at Moosonee, Ontario. He will be expected to defray all expenses to Montreal and home from Moosonee.

I may say that the Department is particularly anxious to co-operate with the scientists and others interested in parasites insofar as they relate to the reindeer and commercial fur bearers in the Northwest Territories. It is hoped that in the present instance we will not only secure information of immediate value but will be paving the way for a more extensive study of the fur cycles and kindred subjects which it is believed have such a bearing on the economic resources of northern Canada.
