FIRST SEDERUNT.

At the City of London, and within St. Andrew's Church there, the twelfth day of June, in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, at half-past secen o'clock in the erening:

Which time and place the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada met, pursuant to appointment by the General Assembly, held at the city of St John, on the twenty-first day of June, last year.

The Rev. George Leshe McKay, D.D., missionary to Formosa, the retiring Moderator, conducted devotional exercises and preached a sermon from Exodus xiv: 15. "And the Lord said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto Me ! Speak unto the children of Israel that they go forward."

Dr. McKay then, with solemn prayer, constituted the General Assembly in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, the only King and Head of the Church.
