D. Diego Carillo de Mendoza y Pimentel, twenty-fourth viceroy of Peru, assumed his title September, 1621. He was cruel and passionate. The disputes which he had with the archbishop Juan Perez de la Serna, of a no less violent temper than that of the viceroy, caused a rebellion to break out January, 1624, which obliged the viceroy to retire to the convent of S. Francisco, from where he embarked for Spain at the end of 1624.
