There were two copies of the instructions, one of which was handed to Mr. Whitney.

One was that evidence might be adduced which would show that the Government was liable to the charges in hand. **COAL STRIKE COMMISSION.**  
**President Has Report and Will Be Made Public Saturday.**  
Washington, March 18.—Judge Gray, chairman, and Carroll D. Wright, recorder of the Anthracite Strike Commission, called on the President today and presented to him the report of the commission. It is a voluminous document covering fully all phases of the controversy between the operators and the miners. The report was promised to abide by the decision of the tribunal created by President Roosevelt.

At the conclusion of the interview with the President Mr. Wright announced that the report would be made public at his office Saturday morning. About the same time it will be placed in the hands of the representatives of the operators and miners, the parties directly interested.
