counter-measures to meet Ludendorft's new ogensive tactics. Against the British on March 21, in the battle if Picardy, these tactics were immediately and tremendously successful. On a narrower front they were equally successful against the French at the Aisne on May 21. It was only in the June attack between Montdidier and Noyon that there was the first hint that an answer had been found, and there a system which had procured an advance of 35 miles in Picardy and an equal distance in Champagne was halted within ten miles.

Bloody Battle Ground.

The country which is now being fought for between Rheims and Verdun has seen some of the bitterest fighting of the war. Back of Rheims the famous Montagne-de-Rheims is a military obstacle of very great importance. The Maronvillers Heights are positions of unsurpassed strength: Even the dusty Champagne country. so bitterly contested in September, 1915, provides the French with admirable positions, their flank covered by the Argonne. When they had the offensive, the French falled to advance more than two miles in the initial attack, but that was before the new system of assault had been devised and while trench warfare was still young. Petain took the Maronvillers Heights step by step after intense artillery preparation, but he had no purpose beyond gaining the immediate objective. Now we are to see what the Germans can do on ground which has measured French offensive ability in two great struggles.

It seems to me that the fate of Verdun, like that of Rheims, is immediately concerned. Any rapid progress southward toward Chalons will create two dangerous salients, with Verdun and
