ARGONAUTS DOWNED BY THE RIVERSIDES

One Goal Margin for East Enders—Scullers Finished Like Whirlwinds.

The Argonaut-Riverside senior tussle at the Arena last night was just the kind of game to warm the hearts of the 6000 old fans, and the scullers staged a real battle to the finish that had the most rabid Riverside fan quaking in his shoes. Riverside scored four goals in the first two periods and they needed every one of these to stall off the fast-coming Argos. It was 4 to 3 at the finish after a most satisfying argument.

Vic Gilbert, the Argonaut captain and star goaler, was unable to play owing to acute stomach trouble, and Burritt replaced Young at right wing. Charles Stewart, late of Kingston, Frontenac, substituted for Gilbert, and made a very fair job of it for a man that has had no practice in the net this season.

Burritt was not the sturdy checker that Young is, and he had a tendency to roam all over the ice. This threw the Argonauts forward line out of their stride, and it was the poor work of the front line in the first two periods that lost the game. Riversides checked hard at all times, while Argos roamed all over the ice and never stuck to their man.

The east enders were able to get their combination working nicely and they took a lift at the intermission. They came within decent shooting distance. It took Argonauts a long time to learn their close, hard checking was the only thing that would stop the Riversides. For two periods they went along breaking up a rush here and there and then fell down with two and three men strung out across the ice. The defence moved up in the last period and put some into the checking and the scullers were all over the Riversides for the last 15 minutes.

Riversides played heady hockey for two periods. They never bunched, checked smartly and shot every time a chance offered. Argonauts were smothered with the swift checking and did almost everything wrong. Charles Stewart showed himself a cool worker, and he was a very busy little fellow for two periods. He cleared a dozen shots from difficult angles and handled himself like a veteran. The Argonauts were not so hard, but they were handicapped when the forward line let Riversides run in two and three at a time.

It was poor hockey in the first period but mighty interesting. Both sides bunched at the start, and Riversides were checking like fiends and boring in. Smith learned his forwards a trick or two when he tried a couple of any kind of shot in the first few minutes that came close to leading in. They all took a hand at it then and shot after shot. The Argonauts were not so good. Stewart was skating all over the pond and Dupp was able to get in some telling hits.

The first goal came 11 minutes after the start. Smith relieved an Argonaut press and set for Stewart with two partners. Smith went straight, and when outside the defence, he laid a one that landed in the corner of the net. With Knight off for a trip Riversides pressed hard again and Grant was the goal mouth to bat in a rebound. There was no further scoring in the first period, but Riversides had the most of the play. Riversides 2, Argonauts 0.

Argonauts had not learned their lesson when the second round opened. Riversides continued to stop them with useful checking. The Argos forwards passed poorly and lost chance after chance. Dupp got the third goal when three men went over the net. Fane shot right at the net. Riversides last goal by interposing an Argonaut's pass and sking right up to the net. Riversides 4, Argonauts 0.

It was Jerry Lafamme who started the Argos on their spurt in the closing round. The tooth-puller opened up a burst of speed and he was the one who stopped the Riverside forwards. The Argonaut front line caught the fever and they checked back like good fellows and bared in like a real team.

Fane broke away nicely and stick-handled his way up to the defence. He held the puck long enough to let Farr rush at the net, unloosed and then gave him a pass. Farr tested it easily. Argos broke for the Riverside net right from the face of the net. Lafamme was the unselfish man. Jerry carried it close, and passed over to Stewart, who had only the goaler to beat. Another nice goal.

The scullers came like mad and made attack after attack. Lafamme was the one who tied up the Riverside defence. He gave Parks a pass with the goaler drawn over. Fane rushed the net. Burritt was hurt, but refused to retire, and then got a goal. Stewart carried it down, shot from the corner and the puck bounded into the net off Burritt's chest. Argonauts could not get the necessary goal and it ended 4 to 3.

The whole Riverside forward line was smooth-working. They knew their job and they stopped in the final period, but it was the Argonaut forwards who were the only ones to play any part in the game. Both defences were good and Collett cleared cleverly all night.

It was a great game to win and a mighty tough one to lose. The attendance was 3221 and the receipts \$2401.50.
