5. Order of business at regular meeting of the society shall be : Minutes Correspondence, Old Business, New Business, Papers Read or Addresses. 6. At all regular meetings of the Society seven shall form a quorum.

8. The President shall preside at all meetings and conduct them after evening of the day the prescribed order of business, shall call special meetings at the reques

of five members. 9. The Secretary shall issue all notices of meetings, keep a correct rec ord of meetings held, shall read minutes and present a full report of the year's proceedings at the annual meeting and shall keep all letters received

10. The Treasurer shall receive. collect, hold and receipt for all fees and money disbursing the same by order of the society.
