\$80,000. A total of \$123,428.22 is provided for public works income—\$2,428,222. The public works estimates chargeable to income are reduced from \$14,224,652 to \$12,796,423.84 under the estimates for 1923-24.

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Among these are \$3,000 for repairs to the Halifax customs house; \$20,000 for an addition to the public building at Sydney; \$8,000 for repairs and improvements to St. John custom house and \$3,000 for the St. John post office; \$12,000 for re-modelling the heating system in Montreal custom house; \$25,000 to re-construct a public building at Alexandria, which had been destroyed by fire; \$7,000 for repairs and reconstruction to the breakwater at Rustico Harbor, P. E. I.; \$25,000 for the reconstruction of the G. T. R. wharf at Lachine; \$16,000 for fisheries patrol station at Poplar Island, New Westminster, B. C.
