I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your favour of the 5th instant, reporting an unfortunate affray at the house of Charles Nahdees on Squirrel Island in which it is supposed that two persons were shot. I note that you acted promptly in placing the matter in the hands of the Crown Attorney, and that his officers are in charge. I note further that you offered a reward of \$10.00 each for the recovery of the bodies and that one body had been recovered. It will be necessary to forward vouchers when these amounts are required.
