

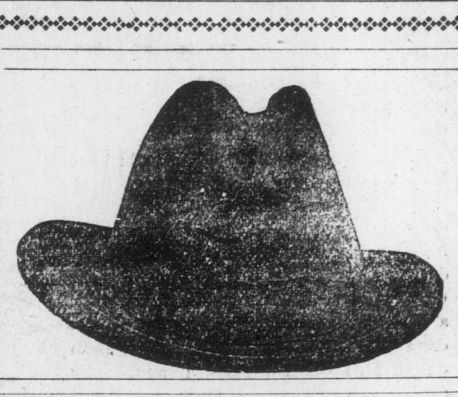

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HEAVY FREIGHTS FROM THE ORIENT

GLENOGLE ARRIVES WITH LARGE CARGO

Topeka Will Be Floated To-morrow, and Hating Towards End of Week--Other Shipping News.

There arrived from the Orient this morning on the Dodwell liner Glenogle 200 tons of general merchandise for local merchants and 2,500 tons for points in the United States.

The City of Topeka leaves the dry dock to-morrow night, and will sail for the north on the 20th.

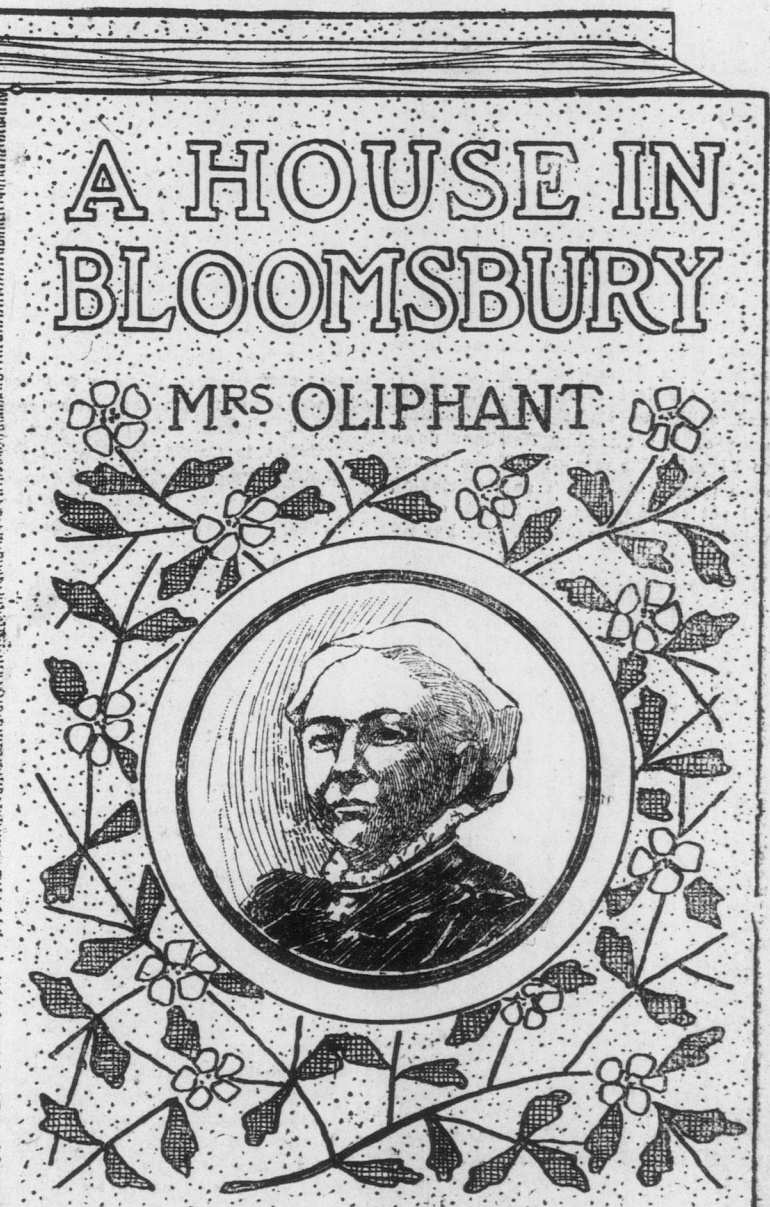
