

LEGAL AND POLITICAL STATUS OF WOMEN.

The only profession now closed to women in Ontario is the ministry.

In the Province of Ontario only, has she full status at the bar. Having all the rights and privileges of a barrister, there is no legal disability to her being a bencher, Queen's counsel or judge.

All women are prohibited from sitting either as aldermen, councillors or as mayors, or as members of either Houses of Parliament, but in Ontario unmarried women may vote at all municipal elections, provided they possess the same property qualifications as men.
