An Act to amend the Act for the qualification of Justices of the Peace.

WHEREAS Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in this Province, who Preamble. are now required to possess a property qualification, suffer inconvenience in consequence of being obliged to renew the oath of qualification on the occasion of the issuing a new Commission of the Peace for the 5 Territorial Divisions of this Province for which such Justices may have qualified themselves to act; For remedy thereof, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. For and notwithstanding any thing contained in the Act 6 Vict., chap. In what cases 3, and intituled, "An Act for the qualification of Justices of the Peace," it only Justices 10 shall not be necessary in the case of any Commission of the Peace to be again under a issued after the passing of this Act, for any such Justice named therein new Comwho may have theretofore qualified himself as provided by the third mission of the section of the said Act, to take any oath of qualification before acting under Peace. such new Commission, unless such Justice shall, since he took such oath

15 of qualification, have parted with the estate in right of which he may have qualified and deposited a certificate thereof in the office of the Clerk of the Peace.
