

An Act to incorporate the Ontario and Huron Railway Company.

WHEREAS it is highly desirable that a Railway should be made from Port Sarnia to intersect the Great Western Railroad at or near the Town of London, and the persons hereinafter mentioned have petitioned to be incorporated for that purpose ; Be it therefore enacted,
5 &c.,

That

together with such other person or persons as shall under the provisions of this Act become subscribers to or proprietors of any share or shares in the Railway hereby authorised to be made, and their several
10 and respective heirs, executors, administrators, curators or assigns, being proprietors of any share or shares in the said Railway, shall be and are hereby united into a Company for constructing, maintaining and working the said Railway, according to the rules orders and directions of this Act, and shall for that purpose be one body corporate and
15 politic by the name and style of "The Ontario and Huron Railway Company ;" and the said Company shall be, and are hereby authorised and empowered from and after the passing of this Act, by themselves, their deputies, agents, officers, workmen and servants, to make and complete
20 a Railway, to be called "The Ontario and Huron Railway," from the foot of Lake Huron at or near Port Sarnia to intersect the Great Western Railroad at or near the Town of London, at such point, as shall be found most convenient and advantageous for the intersection thereof, the said line being first approved by the Governor in Council.

II. And be it enacted, That the Guage of the said Railway shall be
25 five feet six inches.

III. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Company to raise and contribute among themselves, in such proportions as to them shall seem meet and convenient, a competent sum of money for making and completing the said Railway and all such other works, matters and
30 conveniences as may be found necessary for making, effecting, preserving, improving, completing, maintaining and using the said Railway and other works ; Provided always, that the parties herein before named, or a majority of them, shall cause books of subscription to be opened in the City of Hamilton and Town of London, and Village of Port Sarnia
35 and elsewhere as they may from time to time appoint, until the first meeting of Shareholders hereinafter provided for, for receiving the signatures
