under the provisions of an Act passed in the ressels regiseighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "An Act to secure the right of property "in British Pluntation Vessels navigating 5" the inland waters of this Province, and not "registered under the Act of the Imperial "Parliament of the United Kingdom, passed "in the third and fourth years of the Reign of "his late Majesty King William the Fourth, 10" intituled, 'An Act for the registering of Bri" tish vessels,' and to facilitate transfers of "the same, and to prevent the fraudulent assignment of any property in such vessels."

VII. And be it enacted, That for services Fees allowed
15 under this Act the Clerks aforesaid shall be registering entitled to receive the following fees:—For mortgages. fyling each instrument and entering the same in a book as aforesaid, ; for 1s. searching for each paper, ; and the 6d.
20 like fees for copies, as are by law allowed for copies of records kept by them.
