

An Act to amend the "Medical Act of Upper Canada."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Medical Act of Upper Canada"; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 5 **1.** All persons in the study of medicine and who had matriculated at any of the Collèges or bodies mentioned in section four of the "Medical Act" before the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, shall not be subject to the matriculation examination established by the Medical Council; and all attendance at lectures, Certain pupils not subject to matriculation examination, &c.
- 10 at any of the aforesaid Collèges or bodies, and any time not exceeding one year, passed in the study of medicine, with one or more medical practitioners, shall be allowed and recognized under the *curriculum* established by the Council in conformity with the seventeenth section of the aforesaid Act.
- 15 **2.** All persons who may claim registration in virtue of their possessing any of the qualifications enumerated in the third section of Schedule A of the said Act, and who commenced their studies after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, shall be bound to produce evidence of having passed a preliminary examination, Certain persons claiming registration to prove preliminary examination, &c.
- 20 and completed a *curriculum* of studies, equivalent to those now established or hereafter to be established by the Medical Council.

3. Of all penalties recovered under the thirty-fourth section of the said Act, one half shall go to the prosecutor or the party laying the information. Division of penalties.

25 **4.** This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
