

An Act to abolish the Property Qualification now required of  
Members of the Legislative Assembly.

**W**HEREAS by the Act of the Imperial Parliament, commonly called <sup>Preamble.</sup> the Union Act, and by other Acts now in force in this Province, provisions have been made requiring a certain property qualification on the part of members of the Legislative Assembly; and whereas it is expedient that such provisions should be repealed, and the Imperial Act passed in the Session held in the seventeenth and eighteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, chapter one hundred and eighteen, has vested in the Parliament of Canada power to alter or repeal the said provisions of the Union Act :

10 Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

1. So much of the eighteenth section of the Imperial Act passed in the session held in the third and fourth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and chaptered thirty-five, and so much of the thirty-sixth and thirty-seventh section of the sixth chapter of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, or of any other Act, as requires that any property qualification be possessed by any member of the Legislative Assembly of Canada, shall be and is hereby repealed. <sup>Provisions of Law requiring property qualification from Members of L.
