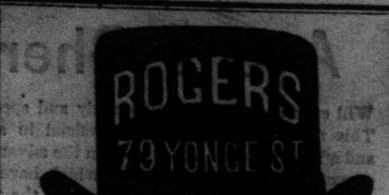

Every Jeweler knows that there is no money in auctioning fine goods, but the profit is made on cheap goods put up to imitate the real thing. If the public knew that they were only buying INFERIOR GOODS AT FIRST GLANCE, these jewelry auction sales would have to adjourn within twenty-four hours for want of a quorum."
