

SUB GUIDE

The Student Union Building is one of the very few of its type in North America to be planned, operated and eventually paid for by the student body. Officially opened in November, 1968 and constructed at a cost of 3.7 million it provides facilities for all student extra-curricular activities and fulfills many of the student's needs.

The Building is situated on University Avenue, between Seymour and LeMarchant Streets. The main entrance faces University Avenue but access can also be had from the side street entrances. Two elevators and three staircases provide accessibility to the building's five levels.
