



Montreal students fight washroom advertisements

MONTREAL (CUP) -Lurking in many washrooms and hiding behind stall doors, bathroom advertisements seem to be omnipresent.

But a group of Dawson College students, calling themselves I Pee Freely, wants to change all that.

"It's an invasion of personal privacy," said Eric Hanson, a second-year creative arts student at Dawson who founded the antiad group. "This is crossing the line as far as advertising goes.

Last week, over 25 students met at an I Pee Freely meeting.

The group decided to pass a petition among Dawson students, and hope to have an anti-ad rally.

But because Dawson, located in Downtown Montreal, is locked into a five-year contract with Zoom Media, the company responsible for supplying washroom ads on campus, the group's efforts may not be rewarded this

Hanson, however, hopes to convince the school not to sign up for another contract

But Drago Kresevic, Dawson's assistant director of Plant Facilities, defended the ads.

'It doesn't do you any harm. Nobody's forcing you to read it," said Kresevic. "It's just there, and the college is benefiting.'
