he Resolution of the 7th Ultimo, the Council of the Moravians of the Thames, requesting the Department to send a Surveyor from Headquarters to make a re-survey of their Reserve, I beg to report that a similar request was preferred by that Council in 1893. No action ap pears to have been taken thereon. A resolution was again passedbby the Council in 1896 to the same effect with the exception that it was not specified that a Surveyor from Headquarters should be sent. I made a survey in 1892 of a drain for agricultutal purposes on the Reserve, and can therefore state positively that the re-survey requested should be made, and I would recommend that it be posted with iron posts I may say that it would not be expedient on -account of the work to be done, to send a Surveyor from Headquarters. I think the Department might act on the Resolution of the 5th May 1896 and ask for an Order-in-Council authorizing the necessary expenditure.
