



I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 27th. instant requesting to be advised whether an Indian's property held within his reserve is exempt from distraint in satisfaction of a penalty imposed upon him for infraction of the law, and in reply to transmit herewith for your information a copy of the Indian Act, and to refer you to Section 105 thereof for a description of such personal property as alone in the opinion of this Department is exempt from seizure of the character to which you refer.
