Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 7th instant, bearing on the application made by Scholastique and Augustine Takkutch for admission to Blue Quill's Boarding School, I beg to say that the Department notes your report that the father of these boys is William Takkutch, a non-treaty Indian, and that he has asked to be admitted with his two sons to Band No 181, Beaver Lake, and paid Treaty, his wife being already a member of that band. I have to inform you that the man and his sons may be admitted to Treaty with the band named. You should make a careful note of the matter in your annuity pay-list book, quoting this letter as authority.

The question of the boys' admission to the school will be taken up later.
