

appointment; and the Department cannot concede that she can fairly claim any salary for the time that lapsed between the date of her application (the 12th July) and that on which she entered upon her duties, viz, the 17th September; and further, it is observed that although you were instructed on the 4th September to make the appointment, yet Miss Parent did not open the school until the 17th September, which would go to show that she was not ready before that date.
